

ANNUAL REPORT, 2019-20

APRIL:

- Session, 2019-20 commenced on 1st April 2019.
- Classes for Baby Class to class X & XII started from 22nd April.
- Ms. B. Surbala, TGT, Dance, was invited by SPIMACAY, Rajasthan to give Lecture Demonstration on Classical Manipuri Dance in different Schools in the State. The invitation came through Padmashri Darshana Jhaveri of the Jhaveri Sisters.
- The school hosted a Capacity Building Programme on Gender Sensitivity on 27th April. 36 teachers from CBSE schools in the state participated. Ms. Soram Sangrila, PGT, History, MMSSS, was the Resource Person. The Programme is part of the CBSE Centre of Excellence (CoE) Undertakings for bringing equity to all CBSE schools in the country. Ms. Jonika (TGT, Mathematics), Mr. Tarun (PGT, Mathematics) of MMSSS participated.

SEPTEMBER:

LiveJam is a social youth movement working among urban teens and youth. The Workshop was part of their It's Not Over Tour 2019 that addresses issues such as suicide, depression, bullying, loneliness etc among teenagers.

- 7th – 10th – Two Marian Football team U-17 & U-19, took part in theCBSE Cluster Games of Guwahati region from 07th to 10th September, held at South Point School, Guwahati. Our U-17 team bagged the Bronze Medal. The Team Manager was Mr. Hawaibam Binoychandra, PGT(Physocs) & Mr. RK Nongdren, PGT (Physical Education)
- On 10th September, Lukanand Kshetrimayum, XII/A/34/ , was conferred the RK Sanatombi Devi Awards 2019 for Excellence in Co and Extra Curricular activities. He was chosen for the award from among student nominees of affiliated CBSE Schools in the state.
- A CBP on Hubs of Learning (HoL), under the CBSE CoE, was held in our School on 29th September for Principal of KV's , JNV's and Sainik School in the State. Principal, Maria Montessori School, Koirengai was the Resource Person & Venue Director.

- 23rd , 24th , 25th – Two teams of students from VIII to XI Team Shiru & Team Sangai – comprising of 5 students each took part in the Tchnoxian international Robotics and World Robotics Championships held at New Delhi from 23rd to 25th September. It was organised by AICRA. They were 28 thousand participants from across the World. We were the first and only school from the state that had student delegates in the Championship. - Mid Term Examinations (Baby to XII) were held from 16th to 27th.
- Puja & Evaluation Break – From 28th September to 9th October.

OCTOBER:-

- After having delegated Students to MUN (Model United Nations) conferences at Sillong and Guwahati for 5 times in the last 4 years, Maria Montessori School organised an MUN Conference at school for the first time in the state, in collaboration with Polaris International Model United Nations, Shillong, from 5th to 7th October. The Inaugural programme was held on 4th October at Hotel Classic Grande with Honourable Dr. Najma Heptulla , Governor of Manipur as the Chief Guest, Mrs. Nengcha Lhouvum Haokip, Former Diplomat as the Guest of Honour and Mr. Ajit Irom, Chairman, School Board of Trustee, MMS as the President. 169 delegates from 17 schools in the state including MMS attended the Conference. The theme of MMS PIMUN 2019 was **COADUNATE CONTRA CONFLICT**.
- On 19th October all the teachers of the school participated in a workshop on Emotional Quotient as Mentors, Reasons to Strive for Excellence organised at the school, in two sessions – One for the PRT's and another for the TGT's & PGT's . The trainers were from Polaris Solution Enterprises, Shillong.
- From 10th to 14th, Life Skills Workshops were conducted for students of IX to XII with Trainers from Polaris Solution Enterprises, Shillong.
- On 17th October, a team of doctors from Dental College, RIMS conducted a workshop on “Foldscope” for children of Class V to teach them about Foldscope, a paper microscope and its application in oral hygiene and also about Oral Health education. It is a part of Department of Bio-Technology, government of India initiative.
- In a very heart warming gesture on 23rd & 24th ,our Health Wellness Club and Interact Club, under the guidance of their Teachers in Charge, Ms. Y. Tangjakhombi & Ms. Y. NIMOTA, carried out a voluntary donation drive from students of class V to XII and the staffs of the school in order to extend financial support to the parents of Thumbelina.... , VIII/A who unfortunately met with a fatal accident on 19th October as she was coming to school with her grandfather for the Parent Teacher meeting. The wholehearted involvement of all the children and teachers in the donation drive was memorable, more so since it was purely voluntary on their part and it was over and above the assistance the school management extended. A total of Rs. 1,37,321 (One Lakh Thirty Seven Thousand Three Hundred Twenty One) was collected on the two days was handed over to Thumbelina and her parents, at Raj Medicity, on 26th October by the School Peer Counsellors and members of Health wellness Club, Manna Phanjoubam, Tennyson Phangabam, Ronaldson Oinam, Estella Thangjam, with Nischay Nongthombam, President and Nick Ningthemcha, Secretary of Interact Club, MMS. The Teacher escorts were Ms. Tangjakhombi, School Counsellor & I/C, Health Wellness Club and Ms. Y. NIMOTA, School Nutritionist & I/C Interact Club.
- In October we also received reports from Educational Initiatives that 61 of our children from Classes III to VIII were selected for the ASSET talent Search which is the most higher level Test conducted for selected students only from the ASSET Examinations conducted nationwide in

August. (ASSET = Assessment of Scholastic Skills through Educational Testing, a Scientifically designed, skill-based assessment test).

NOVEMBER:

- On 24th November, 101 students from Class III to X will participate in the Helicopter Making Workshop to be held in our school an initiative of the Scientific Development and research Organisation (SDRO), New Delhi. Category III to VI will have Making of Infrared Induction Helicopter and Category VIII to X will have Making of Intelligent Infrared Controlled Helicopter. Both are individual activities.

- Two new academic awards have been sponsored from this session onwards (i) Prof. Jodhachandra Sanasam Merit Awards for Highest Marks in Manipur in the Class XI Final Exams conducted by the school, from among the students of Humanities, sponsored by Prof. Jodhachandra Sanasam. - A new project was started this session which we call Personalised learning. Students who do not go for any tuitions at home and/or who are weak in a subject(s) are given provisions to stay back after school each school day for extra tutorial time with the subject teachers concerned. Interested students have joined this learning opportunity & parents come to pick them up from school. This has been started for VI to XII. Necessary arrangements will be made for III to V too after assessment of the needs of the children during this 2nd Term. This project is with no additional fees from the students and with an honorarium of Rs. 500/- Per hour per teacher.
