## Annual Report, 2022-23

# April:

- Session 2022-23 commenced on 01st April 2022.

# Summer Break: 20th June to 02nd July.

## July:

- 04<sup>th</sup> Classes resume
- 5<sup>th</sup> Phase of Covid Vaccination conducted on 12<sup>th</sup> July.
- Owing to a sudden surge in the Covid Positive cases in the state, the government directed all Educational Institutions to be closed from 13<sup>th</sup> July.
- We therefore started our online classes for all levels in the school from 14<sup>th</sup> July.
- Physical Classes at School were opened again for classes 8 to 10 from 25<sup>th</sup> July.
- On 30<sup>th</sup> July, we had our Annual GBM with our Chairman Sir, Mr. Ajit Irom and Director Ma'am, Ms. Laila Gatphoh in the School Conference Hall.

# August:

- New session (2022-23) for class XI commenced on 08<sup>th</sup> August.
- Patriot's Day was observed on 13<sup>th</sup> August. Essay and Poetry Writing, Painting, Slogan writing Competitions were conducted. There were performances of recitation and songs by students and teachers too on the theme of Patriot's Day.

- 29<sup>th</sup> August: School Investiture Ceremony was held on this day. The School Head Boy, Head Girl, House Captains, Vice Captains and Prefects took oath of dedicated service to the school and their houses. National Sports Day was also celebrated to mark the birth anniversary of Indian's Hockey Legend, Major Dhyan Chand.
